NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGE

To be acted upon at the November 15 General Meeting.

Article 8 - General Provisions; Section 2 - Dissolution; B- Disposition of Assets

Current:

If it is decided to dissolve the club, the Board is authorized to dispose of the club's property by any reasonable means and to divide the club's assets equally among those persons who are Qualified Members at the time of the dissolution.

Proposed change:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall distribute the assets of the corporation to such organization or organizations organized and operated as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, for a public purpose as the Board of Directors shall determine.

NOTE: Only active members are eligible to vote on the bylaws change.

Square Foot Contest

Don't forget the Square Foot Contest to be held at the November 15 meeting.

This contest is open to all members.

Build a model railroad scene in an area no larger than one (1) square foot (144 square inches). The shape can be anything so long as the surface area is not more than one (1) square foot and the scene must contain railroad track.

There are two age categories: Junior and all other members ("Seniors"). Only one entry per member is allowed. The prizes: \$25 for the Junior winner and \$50 for the "Seniors." Only one prize will be awarded in each division. In the case of any tie, a drawing will be held. Members in attendance will vote for the winners.

Bring your entry to the meeting. You must be a member in good standing (dues paid) to be eligible. For more info, contact
